

REJECT R-88

Stop Divisive I-1000

This fall, Referendum Measure 88 will be on your ballot. R-88 will be in the title of the ballot measure, yet you will be voting on whether to accept I-1000 or reject it. When you see the words R-88 and I-1000 on the ballot this fall, vote to reject. Again, reject legalized discrimination in Washington.

> I-1000 can be summed up in one sentence: It would abolish the standard of equality for all, regardless of race, as required by the voter approved Washington Civil Rights Act, and replace it with a system that uses different rules for people of different races.

> I-1000 would eliminate the veterans' preference in public employment that has been a legal standard in Washington State since 1895. See RCW 41.04.010 and 73.16.010.

> I-1000 would establish a large GOVERNOR APPOINTED bureaucracy.
